Introduction

The BullCharts software incorporates the concept of "Author Strategies". The strategies have been developed by influential authors and active traders and are implemented in scans, indicators and templates. More details about the concept of Author Strategies are included in Brainy's single-page and free article number BC-26-050.

One of the Author Strategies included in BullCharts is attributable to Stan Weinstein. His thoughts and strategies are documented in his best-selling book "*Secrets for Profiting in Bull and Bear Markets*".

This article in Brainy's series on BullCharts (number BC-26-100) firstly lists all of the related scans, indicators and templates (in the table below), and then provides further information on these items.

This article is intended to provide a good overview of the way in which BullCharts implements Stan Weinstein's strategies, to help you on the road to understanding and implementing them.
